



CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT OF ALBANY EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

As outlined in “Rulers and Regulations of Albany Board of Education” third edition, February 1971, the City School District of Albany, New York defines extraclassroom activities as “...any student body, group or club organized under the sponsor of the school.” Furthermore, “Groups of students wishing to organize an activity which will provide opportunity for increased participation in social, cultural, athletic or other activities found to be desirable and proper by the school principal, may request the principal for the formation of such organization.”

Handicapped pupils throughout the district are provided opportunities to participate in extracurricular activities which are social, academic and athletic. The district also supports Special Olympic activities for students unable to profit from regular sports activities.
