



CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT OF ALBANY OPEN ENROLLMENT

1. Student applying to transfer to any non-magnet elementary school, other than their neighborhood school, will be admitted if space is available and if their enrollment will contribute to greater racial balance within that school.
2. Students applying to transfer to any racially balanced non-magnet elementary school, other than their neighborhood school, will be admitted after students from underrepresented groups, if space is available and provided their enrollment does not cause the school to become racially imbalanced.
3. No student will be allowed to transfer to any racially imbalanced non-magnet elementary school if his or her enrollment will contribute to greater racial imbalance in that school.
These changes will become effective in the 1991-92 academic year. These changes will not apply to students who have already been allowed to transfer under the current policy.
4. In the spring of each year the City School District of Albany will publish and distribute a list of schools and grades where space is anticipated for the coming academic year together with instructions on how to apply for transfer under Open Admissions.
5. The City School District of Albany will establish a procedure for accepting Open Enrollment applications and notifying parents of their decision.
6. The City School District of Albany will provide private bus transportation for Open Enrollment students in grades K-3 who live more than 1.5 miles from the schools they will be attending.
