

Supporting Successful Strategies to Achieve Improved Results (S³TAIR) Project Effective Practice Replication School Grant

Abstract:

The Stephen & Harriet Myers Middle School, in the City School District of Albany is seeking the S3TAIR grant with the objective of developing a model that offers a continuum of effective, research-based academic and behavioral interventions and supports to increase student outcomes for general education and special education students. The model will include a data management system for identifying students' skill deficits through the use of universal screenings and curriculum based measurements that have validated criteria and norms. Student performance on these measures will determine the intensity, frequency and duration of targeted interventions to address specific skill sets. Student progress will be monitored, with the data management system, on an ongoing basis and staff will use a problem solving process to determine intervention effectiveness, identify additional interventions and/ or curricular changes necessary to increase student success.
